## dilution guide

Tested and effective, through certain applications, at a dilution ratio of up to 1:200. Dilute through 30ml dispensing unit for general cleaning.

General cleaning: 1 part concentrate to up to 50 parts water. 1 part concentrate to up to 80 parts water. Light cleaning: Heavy cleaning: 1 part concentrate to up to 10 parts water.





Always wear the correct protective clothing if required. For best results we recommend using the correct dosing and colour coded microfibre cloths please ask your manager for details.

## how to dispose ...

Dirty, used washing solution should be disposed of via drains that lead only to foul sewers. Do not allow detergent solutions to contaminate surface water drains. In the event that concentrated product should need to be disposed of, run small amounts to foul waste, diluting with plenty of water. For larger guantities, seek advice on disposal from the local authorities. Delphis Eco products are packed in fully recyclable containers. Empty containers should be rinsed thoroughly, the washings being run to foul waste. The containers may then be sent for recycling. Dispose of all waste in a responsible manner. Be aware of the environment.
